Digital Commonwealth

Through LFC, the BPL is able to offer free digitization services to cultural institutions across Massachusetts. These treasures are then shared online through the BPL's digital repository managed in partnership with Digital Commonwealth for all to enjoy.

Remote Access via eCard

Over 132,000 active e-cards are being used throughout the Commonwealth, allowing residents to enjoy instant access to online services, including a broad selection of online resources, downloadable e-books, audiobooks, magazines, and music, as well as streaming services offering access to television shows and movies.
